Trial commenced on March 5, 2019. A jury was empaneled and sworn on March 8, 2019 and evidence was presented by the parties. On March 21, 2019 the jury returned a verdict finding the Defendant Not Guilty of the offense of Murder in the First Degree.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED Defendant is hereby acquitted on the charge of Murder in the First Degree, in violation of Iowa Code §707.1 and §707.2.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the above matter is hereby dismissed. Costs are assessed against the State of Iowa.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED all conditions of the Defendant's pretrial release contained in the Order filed December 21, 2017 are hereby set aside. The Marion County Sheriff shall make arrangements for the immediate removal of the GPS monitoring device. The Marion County Sheriff shall immediately return to the Defendant his United States Passport, previously surrendered. The cash bond heretofore posted is hereby released and exonerated.
